Scholarly Paper Criteria

Papers should be between 15-20 pages in length and double-spaced. Appropriate graphs, tables, citations and bibliographic information should be included. A paper previously written for a class assignment may be submitted; however, a clean copy **without** grades or comments must be sent. Please include a cover sheet with your name and institution. You may submit this paper electronically as an attachment to email to the SIE National Office.

Scholarship Winners

Upon evaluation by the SIE National Office staff, the student member writing the best paper will be judged the “Keith Davis Graduate Scholarship Winner,” and receive a \$1,250 cash scholarship and recognition plaque. Two second-place scholarships of \$500 will be awarded to authors of the runner-up doctoral and masters student submissions. Papers must be postmarked by **last business day of current academic year (e.g. May 29, 20XX)**.
